## DECISIONS

- **Summary judgment, wrongful dismissal - *Chu v. China Southern Airlines Company Limited*, 2023 BCSC 21**

Plaintiff demoted twice before being terminated for just cause – plaintiff alleged that defendant engaged in pattern of bad faith abusive conduct, including unfair discipline, insincere warnings, manufactured cause, and public embarrassment – defendant failed to establish just cause – plaintiff awarded 20 months' pay in lieu of notice, as well as well as \$50,000 in aggravated damages for mental distress and \$100,000 in punitive damages
